SEPTEMBER 14 - 26

Return home but you'll want to return to the highlands of Scotland again soon.

SEPTEMBER 14 •••

Arrive in Edinburgh. Meet guide and transfer to hotel. Rest and recover. Welcome dinner. Stay in Edinburgh for 2 nights.

SEPTEMBER 15 •••

Visit all sights with a local deaf guide on the Royal Mile in Edinburgh, including Edinburgh Castle, Abbey, Holyroodhouse, Grassmarket, St. Giles' Cathedral and Greyfriars Kirk.

SEPTEMBER 16 •••

Get ready for a road trip in our private van. Head to visit the Stirling Castle. Swing by the cool Kelpies and fascinating Falkirk Wheel. Weave through the beautiful Loch Lomond and the Land of the Giants before arriving in Oban. Stay in Oban for 2 nights.

SEPTEMBER 17 •••

Hop on ferry and explore all day on Mull Island, especially, on Iona Island where the birthplace of Christianity started in Scotland. Check out the puffin (birds) colony and its beautiful landscapes, including the Fingal's Cave.

SEPTEMBER 18 •••

Drive through the most romantic, scenic glen of all, Glencoe. Stop by the historical town of Fort William which lies on the shores of stunning Loch Linnhe. Continue to the port of Mallaig. Overnight in Mallaig.

SEPTEMBER 19 •••

Board on a ferry to the Isle of Skye. Arrive and explore the port town of Portree. Free time around town. Stay in Portree for 3 nights.

SEPTEMBER 20 • • •

Explore the northwestern part of the Isle of Skye. Head to Neist Point Lighthouse for a nice walk and be in awe of nature. Visit the Dunvegan Castle and its gardens.

SEPTEMBER 21 • • •

Explore the northeastern part of the Isle of Skye. Short hike to see the Old Man of Storr. View the majestic Kilt Rock. Drive up to the jaw-dropping Quiraing and view Scotland from above!

SEPTEMBER 22 • • •

Cross the Skye Bridge and swing by the mystical Eilean Donan Castle. Weave upward through gorgeous Glen Shiel, take a glimpse of the Caledonian Canal and hunt for the Loch Ness creature in the lake. Arrive in Inverness by evening. Stay in Inverness for 2 nights.

SEPTEMBER 23 • • •

A morning walkabout to sights in the city of Inverness. Free afternoon.

SEPTEMBER 24 • • •

Check out the important Culloden Battlefield, the last full-scale battle in UK. Stop by a couple of whiskey distilleries situated on the beautiful Speyside River. Overnight in countryside inn around Speyside region.

SEPTEMBER 25 • • •

Head inside Cairngorms National Park to visit the Balmoral Castle where Queen Elizabeth stay during summertime. Arrive in St. Andrews, home of the oldest golf course. Do a fun mini-putt contest on the famed golf course. Farewell dinner. Overnight in St. Andrews.

Drop off at Edinburgh Airport or in city of Edinburgh for your next destination.
